
Ukraine Crisis: Ensuring Regional Business Continuity

An increasing concern for businesses navigating the <u>evolving crisis in Ukraine</u> is relocating employees from Russia – and in some instances from Belarus and other countries in the region – whether due to employee requests or concerns about ongoing business continuity.

Recommendations for Businesses

- Create internal working groups and designate contact person(s) to act as the decision-making centre. Include both local and headquarter representatives, so they can work together to develop guidance and provide instructions to staff
- 2. Map employee population and prepare employees for possible departure:
 - a. Employees should collect and confirm validity of travel documents and vital records
 - Assess employees' COVID-19 vaccination status and encourage employees to obtain/ update COVID certificates
- 3. Develop a blanket or individual policy approach to your relocation efforts. Will efforts be focused on one single destination country or will several be considered?
- 4. Identify potential exit routes (airports, land border crossings, etc.)



Practical Steps and Considerations for Russian Citizens

- The United States, the European Union, other European countries and Canada have closed their airspace to Russian flights, causing delays in travel routes. Check our <u>Immigration Alerts</u> for the latest developments and contact airlines for the latest on available routes
- Consider where individuals can travel:
 - Personal circumstances: Where do employees have family? Do they qualify for work or family permissions?
 - Office presence: Consider ability to work and stay?
 - Visa processing: Are visas being processed in the destination countries?
 - Visa free options: Russians are visa exempt as visitors in over 50 countries.
